- Original idea assist a school in getting an inventory of their AT equipment/devices

The Survey

- Created a survey on SurveyMonkey.com
- 9 Questions
 - 6 about AT
 - 3 Demographic
- Mailing to 106 Special Education Directors
 - Letter explaining project
 - Paper copy of survey
- Link to survey was sent via e-mail
 - Link to Assistive Technology Survey



Response to Survey

- Responses via mail and electronic survey
 - 21 returned by mail
 - 20 returned via SurveyMonkey
- 41 / 106 = 39% Response Rate
- 218 schools represented



Survey – Pros of Loan/Share Program

- Types of equipment/devices
- Training for staff on equipment/devices
- Ability to try equipment before purchasing
- Get loaners of equipment if needed
- Ability to share equipment that students have outgrown
- Access to the most current AT device for borrow/lease



Survey – Cons of Loan/Share Program

- Availability of equipment
- Long waiting list
- Liability/damage to equipment
- Repair and other costs
- Tracking devices
- Length of time for equipment use
- Training




