

Schedules read from top to bottom.


Only timed stops are listed on the schedule. Times are approximate!





What Mom learned:

- Funding sources: Local community, some Federal and public, grant or private money.
- Coast gets no NH State dollars.
- ADA Paratransit services is available for scheduled door to door if within ¾ mile of bus route.
- Cost/benefits: expanded routes or WC accessible buses cuts other services.

The BIG Picture

- State Department of Transport (DOT) and it's "State Coordinating Council"
 - "Regional Coordinating Councils" (RCC, #9)
 - "ACT" is the RCC for my region
 - RCC works to make a "Locally Coordinated Human Services Transportation Plan"
- Other Players: NH Transit Association, Granite State Independent Living
- Non-Driver & Other Users: Elders, Teens, Low-income, other-abled, environmentally conscious, commuter convenience

What Mom Plans to Do

- Better utilize the COAST system
- Choose housing options that are close to existing bus routes
- Become a member of the Local Regional Coordinating Council
- Start attending the Monthly COAST Board Meetings (open to public) at the McConnell Center in Dover
