

PORTABLE PODIUM

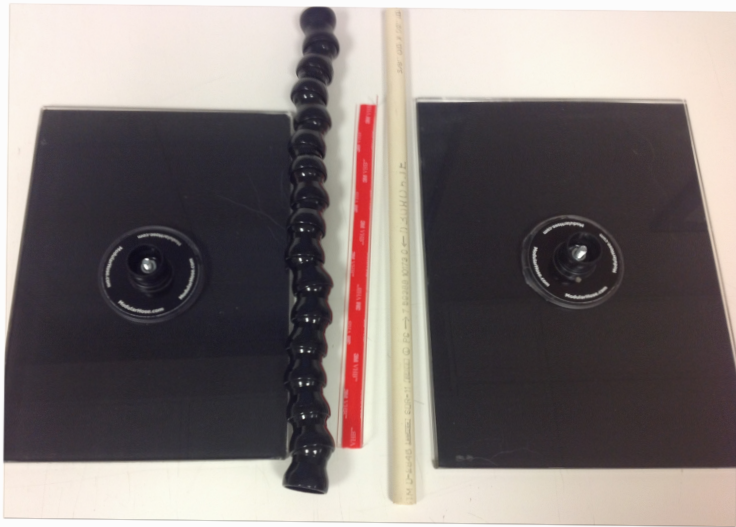
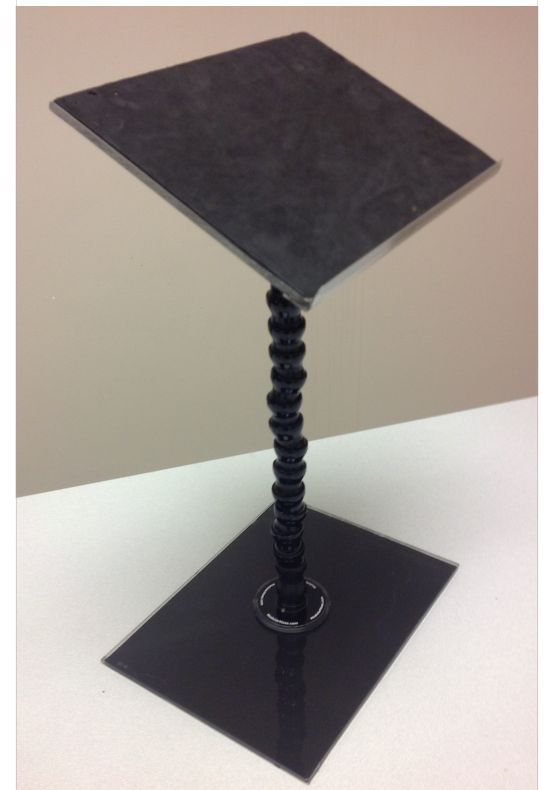

Overview and Materials

This portable podium fits in a backpack and can be taken to a class or a work site allowing you to complete essentials tasks in a standing position.

Materials Needed: An AT Pad Stand with the top removed; 1/2" CPVC pipe; a second base off of AT Pad stand; 3/4" corner guard; and clear 1/2" VHB tape.

Tools Needed: Scissors and a ratcheting PVC cutter



Instructions

Step 1: Attach the Loc-Line to the base and insert the CPVC pipe into the center of the 3/4" tubing. This will make the center post rigid and prevent it from bending.

Step 2: Flip upside down and secure to

the other base.



Step 3: Apply a piece of corner guard to the underside edge of the second base.

Step 4: The podium can be quickly assembled and disassembled for transport in a backpack.

Step 5: The portable podium can be used for supporting a keyboard; as a book holder; taking notes; and a tablet computer holder.
