GOALS/OUTCOMES:

 All students receive Recess booster lesson and positive acknowledgement for Gecko Excellence at Recess.

Recess Lesson Plan for Recess Focus Week:

Classroom Teacher Role:

- Provide Pre-Correction:
 - o "This week is the Recess Focus Week..."
 - Review recess routines and expected behaviors that were taught in Week 1.
 - Refer to Recess Matrix located in the classroom for identification of specific routines and behaviors.

Recess Lead Teacher Role:

- Mary/Carrie will select a Recess Lead Teacher for each grade.
- Recess Lead Teacher will assess the grade's need for review and practice of Recess routines and behaviors, resulting
 in:
 - o *Minimally (on the playground)*, a verbal review of Recess routines and expectations with student engagement and student modeling (see Recess matrix).
 - Maximally (on the playground), re-teach Recess routines and behavioral expectations using full Recess lesson plans as used in Week 1 (involve Carrie or Kelly as needed).
- Remind students that Gecko Excellence is expected whenever you are at Recess.
- Continue to use language from the Recess matrix when reminding/correcting Recess behavior.

Recognition for Recess Focus Week:

- Each Classroom will have a Chart entitled "We can Show "Gecko Excellence" during Recess"
 - o Each chart will contain each student's name in a grid (each student name within a square in the grid).
- A Color dot (sticker) is awarded to students when "Gecko Excellence" during Recess is observed by the Recess monitor.
- When shown to the classroom teacher, the teacher (or student) will place a colored dot in the chart in the square corresponding to the student's name.
- When ALL student's squares have a "dot" the whole class has earned a "Big Gecko".
- "Big Geckos" for Recess Excellence are displayed by classroom/grade in the cafeteria.
- When all classrooms in a grade have earned one "Big Gecko" the grade has earned a "Gecko Excellence Certificate" presented by Mrs. Hill.
- High rate verbal recognition for Recess Excellence throughout week.
- When all grades have earned their certificate everyone receives a "Whole School Acknowledgement" for Gecko Excellence at recess.

Fidelity Check:

- Recess Routines and Behaviors are posted in classroom
- Recess Excellence Charts posted: All students receive dots within one week
- Big Geckos visible in cafeteria
- Certificates visible in cafeteria
 - Non-classroom teacher role: Verbally acknowledge when students are observed displaying Gecko Excellence by following Recess expectations.
