Our Mission

The mission of School Street School is to foster a love of learning, a feeling of self-accomplishment and responsible citizenship which will provide all students with the resources and skills needed in an ever-changing and challenging world.

How does meeting align with mission?

- **It provides students and staff a chance to experience what is honored by the community, which is responsible citizenship, and includes the recognition of developing academic, leadership and social skills**
- **It provides students and staff a chance to connect and have fun**
- **It allows students opportunities to observe other students teaching social skills and then the chance to practice it immediately with peers and adult support as needed**

The designated classroom opens the community meeting with:

- Greeting (an opportunity to practice greeting peers and teachers in a prosocial manner in real time)
- Share (an opportunity to speak and to be heard with/by students and staff)
- Activity (an opportunity to engage with many classmates, possibly off grade level, with laughter and movement)
- Celebration of Learning (an opportunity to reinforce that this is a place of learning and that learning is valued)

The principal or designee will continue the community meeting with:

- Key Messages (an opportunity to communicate what has been seen or experienced as a community member- and to reinforce what is valued in our community)
- Awards (an opportunity to recognize any individual or small group progress, academically or socially)
- Birthdays – students & staff with birthdays stand up front and the building sings to them (an opportunity to have your special day recognized by your school)
- Five names are drawn from a basket & children select small tokens from a treasure chest or basket of stuffed animals (an opportunity to receive a small token for being a member of the school)

We recite The Pledge of Allegiance.

The meeting is declared completed by principal or designee.
