

### Prevalence of Disability in NH is Highest in the North Country

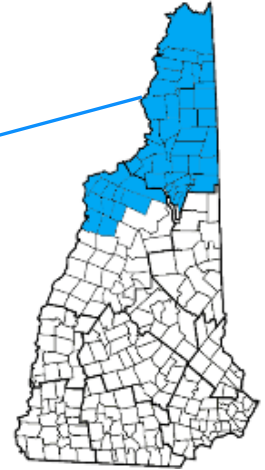
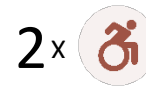

More than 237,000 adults in New Hampshire (NH) have a disability. The prevalence of disability is highest in the North Country, where 1 in 4 adults reports hearing, vision, mobility, and/or cognitive disabilities.

Compared to the rest of NH, people in the North Country are twice as likely to have hearing and/or mobility disabilities.



#### Strategies to promote regional public health for people with disabilities in NH:

- Include people with disabilities in regional health collaborations such as Public Health Networks and Integrated Delivery Networks.
- Improve the accessibility of public health programs for people with disabilities across the lifespan.
- Evaluate and improve the physical accessibility of all healthcare, housing, and transportation services.
