Why Implementation Science?

For meaningful, lasting change to happen, certain structures and systems need to be in place from the outset and supported over time. Failed change efforts can be costly, not to mention demotivating for staff.

Understanding the key elements of implementation science and how to activate proven implementation strategies helps teams to protect the time, money, and energy they invest in their work.

This training will give teams the tools they need to apply a systematic approach to launching a new (or examining an existing) project or practice.

This training is for teams of 3+ people who have a specific project to work with throughout the training. Teams will leave with an action plan and other customized tools to support their success.
