Timeline continued...



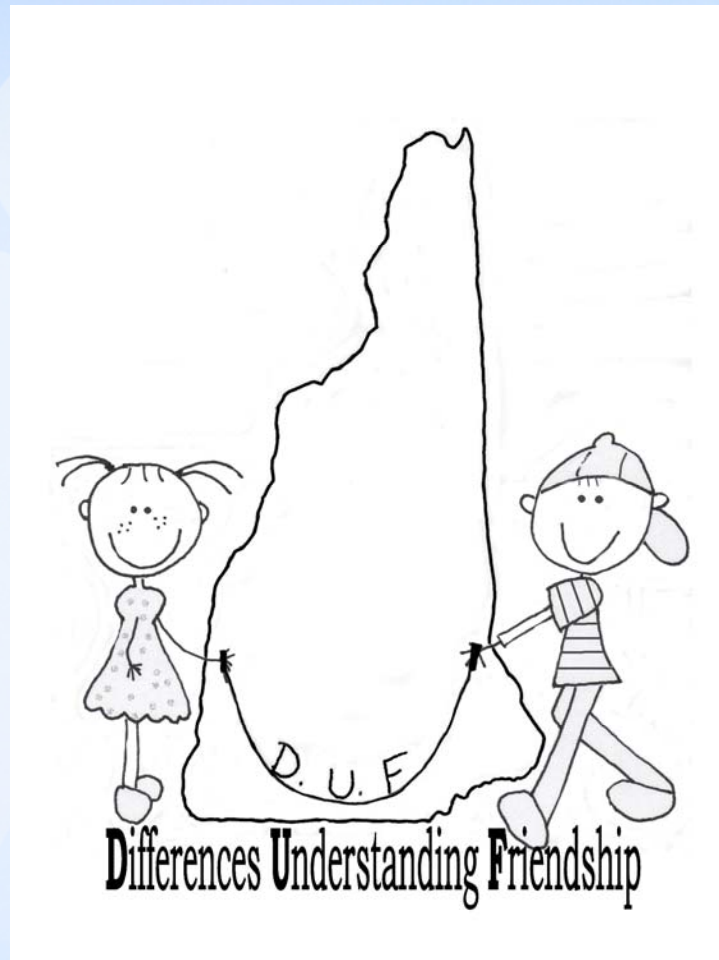
- Meeting at the IOD to discuss possible grants to use for the project. Drafted a letter. Group name was developed for grant application.
