Granite State College Credit information

If you are interested in pursuing nine college credits towards a Granite State College degree following your participation in the NH Leadership Series, you can apply to Granite State College using this link:

Upon submission of your completed application and required documents, a member of the GSC Admissions team will communicate with you regarding next steps including an assigned academic adviser.

To review how your credits are applied to a degree at GSC, please consult GSC's Transfer Equivalency System (TES) linked here [GSC TES PLA University of New Hampshire IOD](#). Once in TES, enter "PLA" in the institutional Search bar, then find "UNIVERSITY OF NEW HAMPSHIRE- INSTITUTE ON DISABILITY" in the list of PLA Institutions.

Please note the dates of attendance are key in the award of credit. Dates published in TES require a \$350 flat fee covering the submission of training credentials and experiences for a year. If your UNH IOD training reflects years prior to the published dates in TES, kindly consult the GSC Admissions team member assigned to you upon application for further information.
