

Week 6 Focus: HALLWAYS (QSR)

GOALS/OUTCOMES:

- All students receive booster lesson in QSR and positive acknowledgement for Gecko Excellence in the Hallway

Hallway Matrix:

Be Respectful	Be Responsible	Be Safe
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quiet, Straight, to the Right (QSR) <p>Quiet Means: Quiet means that mouth, hands and feet are very quiet. Feet walk gently. Hands are by your side. Mouths whisper.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quiet, Straight, to the Right (QSR) <p>Straight Means: Straight means that you are in a straight line. Go straight to your destination. Keep hands and body off walls, doors, and bulletin board.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quiet, Straight, to the Right (QSR) <p>to the Right Means: Stand to the right of the hallway and stairways so you do not bump into anyone coming in the opposite direction. Always keep your place in line.</p>

QSR Lesson Plan for Hallway (QSR) Focus Week:

- Post QSR signs in Classroom and Hallway.

Classroom Teacher Role:

- Describe ***Gecko Excellence*** as it applies to Hallway behavior
 - Teachers may use QSR powerpoint to aid instruction.
- “Remember the QSR video?” (can show again if needed/wanted)
 - Review “QSR” and describe each behavior:
 - “When you use **QSR** behaviors in the hallway, you are demonstrating *Gecko Excellence!!*”
 - Q stands for ***‘Quiet’*** which is important when we walk in the hallways so we can be respectful of students who are hard at work in their classrooms.
 - S stands for ***‘Straight’*** which reminds us to keep in a straight line and go straight to your destination.
 - R stands for ***‘to the Right’*** which reminds us to always stay to the right so you don’t bump into others and we keep our hallways safe.
- Ask students to describe and demonstrate:
 - Who can model and tell us what ***Quiet*** means and looks like in the hallway?
 - Who can model and tell us what walking ***Straight*** looks like in the hallway? What does it mean to go straight to your destination?
 - Who can model and tell us what walking ***to the Right*** looks like in the hallway?
- Now, let’s practice Gecko Excellence by using QSR together in the hallway.
QSR starts when we line-up in the classroom. Let’s practice!
- Class practices Quiet & Straight line-up and then practices QSR in the hallway.
- Provide individual and whole class verbal praise for Gecko Excellence!

Recognition for Hallway (QSR) Focus Week:

- **This week, each Classroom will have a Chart entitled “We can show “QSR” in the hallway”**
 - **Each chart will contain each student’s name in a grid (each student name within a square in the grid).**
- **A sticker (dot) is awarded to students when “Gecko Excellence” (QSR) is observed by the classroom teacher.**
- **When ALL student’s squares have a “dot” the whole class has earned a “Big Gecko”.**
- **Once a “Big Gecko” is earned for QSR, the Big Gecko should be displayed on the classroom door.**
 - **This is the sign to all other staff that this classroom is ready to receive acknowledgement from other staff members who observe QSR exhibited by members of that class (or the class as a whole).**
- **Each time a class, or a member of that class, is acknowledged for QSR, a Big Gecko should be added to the classroom door.**
- **When a classroom has earned FIVE Big Geckos, the class receives a “Classroom High Five” from Mrs. Hill or Mrs. Sindoni.**
- **When all grades have earned their “High Five”, a “Whole School Acknowledgement” is provided for Gecko Excellence.**
- Remember, ***The Grinnell Gecko*** is looking for Gecko Excellence all day long whenever you are walking in the hallway –

Fidelity Check:

- **QSR behaviors are posted in the classroom**
- **QSR Chart posted in classroom: All students receive dots within 2 days.**
- **Big Geckos are posted on classroom door**
- **Non-Classroom staff provide 2/day Big Gecko acknowledgement to classrooms and individuals/groups in hallways**
- **Classroom Teachers provide 1/day (to another classroom) Big Geckos to other classrooms**
- **Each class earns 5 Big Geckos**
